



PRIVACY STATEMENT ABOUT PERSONAL INFORMATION OF ARMY RUN PARTICIPANTS

This statement applies to extreme obstacle races ARMY RUN.

ARMY RUN s.r.o., ID No.: 07297181, with its registered office at Na Balkáně 450/25, Vysočany, 130 00 Praha 3, a contractual relationship between the organizer and the participant is formed by registration to this run. This statement is an integral part of the contractual relationship between the organizer and the participant.

By completing registration to the race the participant gives consent free of charge, in accordance with Act No. 101/2000 Coll., Personal Data Protection Act and Act No. 480/2004 Coll., On Information Society Services, for personal data processing to the organizer, the administrator of personal information, for the purpose of evaluation of the race and sending of information messages by the organizer or third party, and all of that for an indefinite period of time. Such personal information will not be made public with the exception of name, surname and the information about his/her trade on the score board. The participant is aware of the fact that he has access to his personal information and that he also has other rights according to the Section 11 a 11 of the Act No. 101/2000 Coll. The consent is given voluntarily and the participant can revoke the consent at any time and free of charge at the address of the organizer. The participant agrees that his personal information can be transmitted for the purpose of providing health care in connection to the race or to a third party for commercial purposes.

By completing registration to the race the participant gives explicit consent (license) to the organizers for the acquisition and use or broadcast of his portraits, photos, images and video or audio recordings related to the participant or his personal expressions taken during or immediately before or after the race (including the events before or after the race). The captured materials can be used to propagate organizer of ARMY RUN at any time and to commercial purposes. The participant is not entitled to any reward or compensation for this use.

The participant expressly agrees that the organizer is entitled in accordance with the Act No. 101/2000 Coll., Act No. 89/2012 Coll, the Civil Code, to use his personal information, free of charge, in medias (including the internet or social media), in commercial or advertising materials of the organizer and also the audio and photo recordings of the participants can be captured or published in

the above mentioned way for the duration of ten years after the completion of the race.

The organizer is also entitled to transfer the given personal information to an entrusted person, who provides timekeeping and evaluation of the results of the race and to the distribution of photographs of the participants of the race taken during the race.

If there are any discrepancies between Czech and English version of this privacy statement, the Czech version shall prevail.
